Your first steps onto the campsite

- Upon arrival you can temporarily park your vehicle in the arrival area and check in at Reception. We will be very happy to welcome you and you'll be given a barrier pass, so that you can drive onto the campsite.
- Your reserved pitch will be ready for you from 14.00 hrs. On the day of departure, please vacate your pitch by 11.00 hrs. Should you wish to extend to your holiday and stay longer, please ask at Reception. We will do all we can to accommodate you!
- If you wish to stay longer than your original booking, please inform Reception as soon as you can. Your pitch may have been reserved by someone else already, but even if that were the case, we can try to find a solution.
- Payment must be made in advance, as indicated on your booking. We regret that no refund can be given upon cancellation, and advise taking out an insurance policy with cover for cancellations.

Supermarket

Spar supermarket is centrally located on the campsite. The shop offers a wide choice of rolls freshly baked on the premises, as well as many other fresh and convenience products. In addition there are gas bottles and canisters (practically any size and make), camping needs, non-food items, (beach) toys, national newspapers and magazines. Organic produce is also available. The shop is open 7 days a week, throughout the camping season. The daily opening hours are displayed in the shop window.

Duinpaviljoen Zoen aan Zee

Duinpaviljoen Zoen aan Zee has a trendy beach atmosphere! Whether you like a dreamy glass of wine by the open fire or enjoy a nice piece of fish, it's all here. Next to the restaurant is a large children's playground. Please ask at Reception for the opening times.



Internet



The campsite is covered by wireless internet, access to which can be arranged at Reception. Around Reception and in the dune pavilion there is a free Wi-Fi connection, so you can go for a nice cup of coffee and check your emails at the same time. Bear in mind that it will be slightly different from your connection at home: streaming is not possible, and it may take a little longer to open a page than you are used to.

Would you like to discover the dunes or the surroundings by bicycle? Head to our bicycle rental Behind the Beach! Behind the Beach has a large assortment of all things bicycle, from tandems to 7-speed touring bikes. Behind the Beach is located next to Reception, and is open daily.
